The International Organization for Migration is seeking qualified Turkish Nationals and non-Turkish nationals holding a valid residence permit for the following position based in Istanbul, Turkey.

Established in 1951, IOM is the leading inter-governmental organization in the field of migration and works closely with governmental, intergovernmental and non-governmental partners. IOM is dedicated to promoting humane and orderly migration for the benefit of all. It does so by providing services and advice to governments and migrants.

IOM is committed to a diverse and inclusive environment. Internal and external candidates are eligible to apply to this vacancy. For the purpose of the vacancy, internal candidates are considered as first-tier candidates.

General Functions:

Under the overall supervision of the Head of Sub Office in Istanbul and direct/operational supervision of the Senior Field Security Assistant in Istanbul, the Security Intern will support the current Senior Field Security Assistant Istanbul (FSA) to effectively implement all appropriate security management procedures, related to the safety and security of /OM staff and the protection of /OM assets in the sub-office. Work with the Operations Officer on activities and operational procedures for general return, reintegration, and resettlement. This may include responsibilities related to travel, transit, reception and onward processing of refugees, as well as follow-up on specific reintegration-related mechanisms;

Major Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Primarily support the Senior Field Security Assistant (FSA Istanbul) in all tactical, operational, and strategic security matters that impact IOM's staff safety and security, IOM's operations and programs in his area of responsibility (all IOM premises under the SO Istanbul).
2. Support the FSA in the conduct of required security assessments/evaluations, threat analysis, and risk assessments and offer appropriate recommendations.
3. Support the FSA to develop and implement evacuation/emergency security plans requested by the country FSO or the HoSO.
4. Prepare and execute security and safety-related training sessions and briefings for national and international IOM staff members.
5. Assist the FSA in planning, follow-up, execution, and control of security-related construction/modernization/improvement programs under the SO Istanbul accountability.
6. Support the FSA in the preparation/updates of security briefings for the Head of Sub Office and IOM personnel under their responsibility.
7. Provide IOM security representation in SO Istanbul at all security-related meetings including UN Security Management Team, security cell meetings, telecommunications working group meetings and other security-related meetings where the Head of Sub Office or country FSO are unable to attend.

8. Support the SFA for liaising with local Istanbul security authorities and the UN/IGO security community to ensure safe passage of IOM personnel and vehicles during times when such movement is restricted.
9. Support the supervision of IOM premises security guards under the Istanbul Sub-Office accountability and monitoring the use of MOSS equipment to ensure they are all in good working condition.
10. Perform other such duties as assigned by the country FSO or HoSO SO Istanbul.

Required Qualifications:

Education:

- Enrolled in the final academic year or graduated within one year of a Bachelor's Degree in Security Management, Criminology, Political Science or a related field from an accredited academic institution, or
- Equivalent studies in Military or Police Academy, or
- Enrolled in a graduate school programme (second university degree or equivalent, or higher).

Experience:

- Proven ability to anticipate and prepares adequate responses to matter affecting staff safety/security;
- Experience working in security management, law enforcement or military disciplines is a pre-requisite, preferably with international experience;
- Good understanding of electronic mapping systems {ArcGIS, Google Earth}; and
- Previous military or police experience with Turkish National Police/ Turkish Military Forces are advantageous.

Languages:

- Fluency in **English** is required.
- Knowledge of **Arabic** is advantageous.

Required Competencies

Values

- **Inclusion and respect for diversity:**
